CONDUCTOR NOTIFICATIONS

NOTIFICATION #1: EMPLOYEE AWARENESS

Over the past several months there has been an increase in thefts of Metro-North property in the care of Metro-North Conductors. Most of the stolen property consists of Ticket Stock and on one occasion a conductor's ticket punch was stolen. At this time all Metro-North Conductors should be extra vigilant when securing railroad property while on and off duty. Two of the thefts investigated were from the personal vehicles of conductors. At this time the police department is unable to link any of these incidents to each other.

NOTIFICATION #2: LOST / STOLEN TICKET STOCK

If you are presented with an on-board ticket from a commuter that you did not directly sell/punch, please examine the stock for the below listed serial numbers. The below listed serial numbers are that of ticket stock that was reported lost or stolen by/from Metro-North Conductors. If you encounter an individual in possession of the below serial numbered ticket stock, attempt to confiscate the ticket and notify the RTC immediately. Advise the RTC to have the MTA Police respond to the next station stop. Hold the train doors at the next station stop and await the arrival of MTA Police or local law enforcement officials. Do not attempt to apprehend or detain anyone possessing the below listed stock.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Do not leave large amounts of U.S. currency in your locker or break rooms while on/off duty.
2. When off duty do not wear identifying clothing/uniform shirt especially when heading home after your shift. If you wear your uniform to and from work, cover up with an outer garment.
3. Do not leave railroad property inside your personal vehicle.
4. Report any suspicious conditions or person(s) to the MTA Police immediately.
5. Make frequent checks of your personal & work property while working on board equipment.
6. Make sure you identify all subjects riding in dead-head equipment. Check their identification if they are not known to you personally.
7. Limit the amount of ticket stock that you take with you while on-board equipment and deposit railroad cash as soon as possible.
